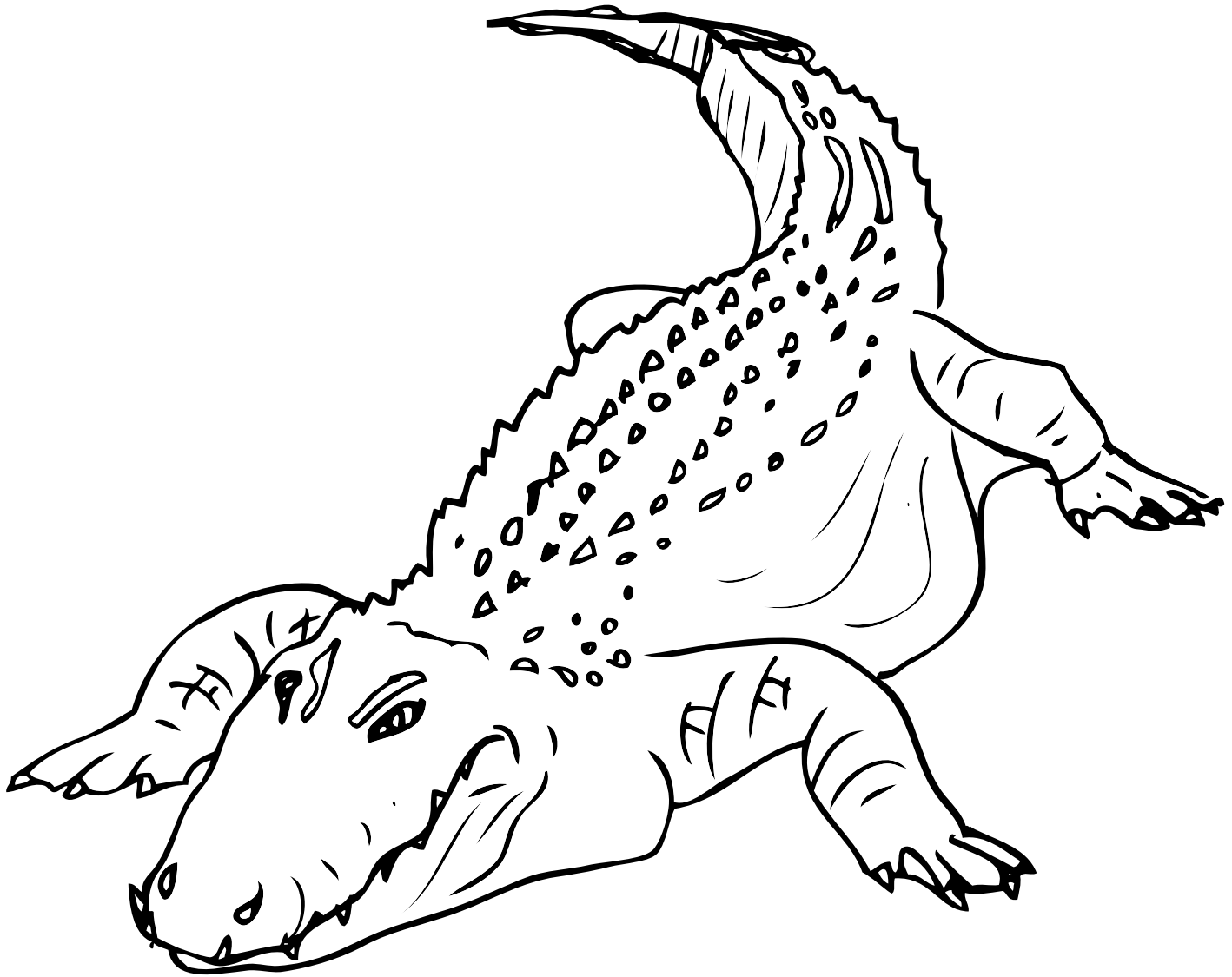




American Alligator
