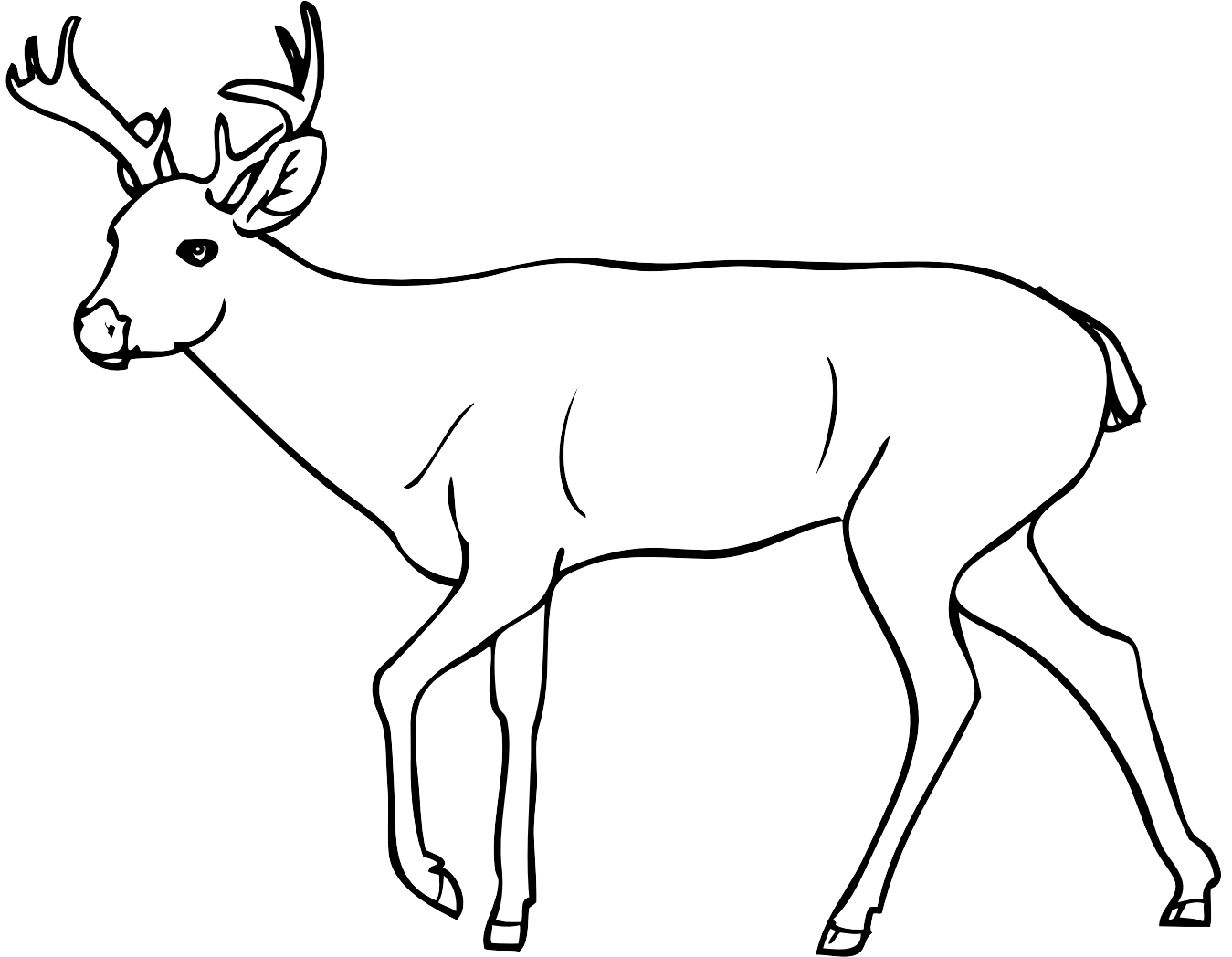




White-tailed deer
